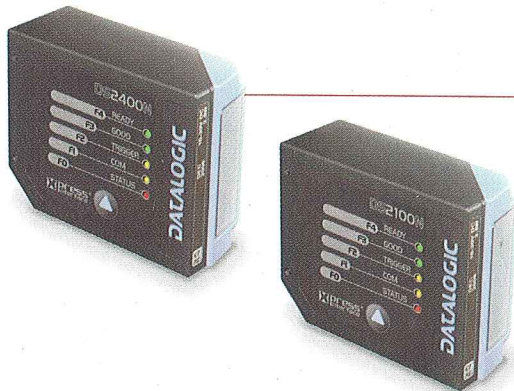

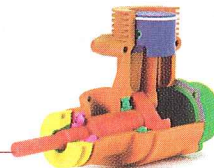
BLACKBERRY FOR THE ENTERPRISE
